- Please adhere to all precautions for correct operation.
- This manual contains important information about how to use the chair safely and correctly, avoiding possible damage to property or injury to persons using the chair and others.
- To clearly indicate the degrees of danger and damage, symbols "warning" and "caution" should shown below to highlight important safety instructions.

If there is a threat of lightning, abnormal noise (any abnormality), turn off the main power switch. For the safety, contact the vendor for inspection. Do not try to repair any malfunction of the chair.

Regular maintenance will preserve the life of your chair.

Have you experienced any of these problems?

- The chair can not start with the main power switch set to ON. If you find anything listed on
- The power cord has been cracked or scratched.
- The power cord or plug becomes abnormally hot.
- The chair produces a burnt smell, abnormal sound or vibration.
- The auto timer function does not work in some cases.
- Other failures.

If you find anything listed on the left,stop using and unplug the power cord from the outlet to prevent failure or an accident. Be sure to contact the vendor or our service

center for maintenance.

To use safely

The chair fabric is a consumable part with service life of 3 years.

(Continuous of use: 2times a day with each cycle 15 minutes).

For safe use, periodic inspection is recommended before the end of its service life.

Durable years vary depends on conditions of use.

*After 5 years of use, a professional inspection is recommended even if there are no symbols or problems. For inspection cost please contact the vendor.

CARE AND STORAGE

STORAGE

- Loose the hasp, fold the chair back into the chair.
- If the chair is left unused for a while, cove the chair to prevent from dust.
- Pets sometimes chew on power cord, try to keep the pets away from the chair even when it is stored.



 Do not install the chair where it can come into contact with direct heat, such as direct sunlight or a radiator.

CARE AND MAINTENANCE

∆CAUTION

• When cleaning the chair, be sure to unplug the chair from the outlet. Do not plug or unplug the chair with wet hands.

Caring for the back cushion and covers

Soak a piece of soft cloth in lukewarm water in which a small amount of mild detergent has been added. Then thoroughly wiring it out before cleaning off any spots or grime.

∆CAUTION

• The fabric color can change if the chair is in contact with vinyl covers or wall coverings for a prolonged period of time.

[Caring for other plastic parts]

Soak a piece of soft cloth in lukewarm water in which a small amount of mild detergent has been added. Thoroughly wiring it out. Clean off any spots or grime. Then wipe with a dry cloth so that no detergent residue remains.



Do not use alcohol based or other household cleaning products or abrasive because they
can scratch or crack the finish or cause color to fade.

[Care for the controller]


Wipe dirt off the controller with dry cloth.

∆CAUTION

Never use a moistened or wet cloth. Or it may result in accident.

TROUBLE SHOOTING

If there is still a problem after trying the solutions given in this troubleshooting guide, stop using the chair immediately to avoid injury or incident. Unplug the chair from the outlet, contact the vendor or your nearest service center for assistance.





WARNING



The following persons must not use the chair.

Persons who have thrombosis, serve aneurism, acute varicosity, skin infection, subcutaneous tissue inflammation.

Persons with any of the following conditions should seek medical advice before using.

- 1. People who have electronic medical devices easily susceptible to electromagnetic interference.
- 2. People with malignant tumors.
- 3. People with serious heart disease.
- 4. Woman who is in menstrual period or pregnant.
 - 5. Sensory disturbance caused by peripheral circulatory disorder due to diabetes.
 - 6. People with sensory disturbance.
 - 7. Persons being treated for personal injury.
- REQUIRED ACTION 8. High fever (38'C or higher) such as acute inflammation, high blood pressure or chills.
 - 9. Persons with sickness or under bed rest orders.
 - 10. Osteoporosis, spinal fractures and acute pain.
 - 11. Inflammation due to sprains and muscle strain.

It is not recommended for those who are in uncomfortable and sickness.

Keep massage to no more than 15 minutes in length. Do not continue to massage an area specific of any particular of your body. Please stop for at least 30 minutes before reuse. Continue using for extend periods of time can result in over stimulation on muscles and nervous.



WARNING



Do not use the chair when your body is wet. It could result in electric shock or malfunction.

ORBIDDEN WET HAND



Do not spill water or other liquid on the chair. Do not place it in the humid environment like bathroom. It may result in electric shock or malfunction.

GUARD AGINST DAM



Make sure no one especially pets in the way when operation.

REQUIRED ACTIO

Do not try to disassemble or repair the chair, power cord and controller. It may result in fire and malfunction.

DO NOT DISASSEMBLE

Do not destroy the power cord.



The power cord should not be broken or damaged. Do not bend, stretch, twist or wrap the power cord. Do not hang up objects on the power cord. The broken cord will result in electric shock, short circuit or fire,

SAFETY PRECAUTIONS



WARNING

This product is not intended for use by children and persons with reduced mental capabilities. Keep children and persons with reduced mental capabilities away from the chair during operation.

Do not use the product with anything other than an AC220V power source. Do not wrap the power cord around the main body or it will result in electric shock, short circuit and fire.



Do not let children sit and play on the product or it will result in injury and malfunction.

During the operation, do not put your fingers into the gap between the housing and cushions or it will result in injury and accident.

Do not use the chair to massage head or stomach, or it may result in nausea or injury

Do not use the chair unclothed. It may harm your skin.

Should the fabric cover be broken or removed, please do not use the product.

If you feel uncomfortable during use, please stop the product immediately and consult with your doctors.

CAUTION



 In the event of power failure, switch off the main switch and disconnect the power plug to prevent any sudden operation if the power is restored unexpectedly.



Do not touch outlet, plug and power cord with wet hands.



- After use or in the event of power failure, please disconnect the power plug to prevent electric leakage, electric shock and accident.
- In the event of cleaning the product, please disconnect the power plug to prevent electric shock and fire.
- When disconnecting the power plug from the socket, be sure to hold the plug instead of pull over the power cord. Or it will result in electric shock, short circuit and fire. Please check power plug and power cord as schedule.



- Do not use the product immediately after drinking and dinner. Or it will result in uncomfortable.
- Do not hangup heavy objects with power cord and control wire. Do not drop the controller or it will result in electric shock and fire.
- PROHIBITED Do not use the product near the fire or heater device. Do not smoke while you are using. Do not place the product on the floor where there is underground heating or other heating device. Or it will result in fire.

AFTER USE

Raise the backrest up straight completely then lower down the footrest.

Switch off the main power switch.

Unplug the power plug from the outlet. This is to lowerest power consumption (energy saving).



After use, please turn off the main power switch and unplug the power plug from the outlet, or it will result in injuries caused by children and pets. After use, please raise the backrest up straight and lower the footrest completely.

After use, please clean it and place it in the dry place.

When unplugging the power cord, please do not pull it over, instead, you should unplug it pinching the power cord.

Pull the power cord out of the socket after using.

Please be sure to put the power cord away in prevention of tripping over.

Change Course

During massage, you can interchange to other courses, MANUAL→AUTO AUTO ➡ MANUAL

Stop Massage

Press ON/OFF button, the rollers wi return back to its intial position, and massage functions stop.

In case of abnormal running or uncomfortable, stop using by pressing "STOP". For safety of the users, all mechanical movement will be locked and airbags begin to deflating. Press ON/OFF, the rollers will return back to its intial position.

- If you feel the massage is too strong, reduce the stimulation according to this operation manual. If this solution does not work, stop using and contact the vendor.
 - \rightarrow Or it will result in injury if you continue use with high stimulation under such circumstances.



- Do not place your hands or feet into the roller tracks, the gap between the reclining back and seat or into the moving parts. Do not sit wearing hard objects, such as hair accessories, or a necklace, watch, bracelet or ring.
- If your leg or foot comes out of the legrest during the massage, do not try to force it back in.
- Keep massage sessions to no more than 15 minutes in length. Do not exceed 5 minutes for area specific massage of any particular part of the body.
 - →Continuous use for extended periods of time can result in over stimulation, which could cause the opposite of the desired effect or even injury.

The total amount of time for a daily massage should be limited to about 30 minutes.

CAUTION

- Do not pull or crash the fabric cover with sharp implement, like knife. Or it will result in injury and malfunction.
- Do not unduly twist stretch the power cord or it will result in fire.
- Do not drop off the controller, avoid the contoller from external impacting. Or it will result in malfunction.
- Should any broken on the power cord and power plug, or any loosen on the outlet, please do not use the product, or it will result in electric shock, fir and accident,
- Do not put your fingers into the gap of the chair when reclining the chair.
- Do not force overloading on each function courses or it will result in malfunction and injury.
- Do not use the product when you fall in asleep. Use with unconsciousness will result in injury and uncomfortable.
- Do not unduly pull over the product from the wooden floor, carpet or other place which is easily scratched.
- Please carry and move the chair carefully to avoid scratching the floor.





CAUTION

This product is designed for home use and not for commercial purposes.

Do not operate the chair coveed by a blanket. Excessive heating will occur and cause fire and accident.

Make sure the well connection between the plug and the outlet. Wipe dust away from them, or it will result in electric shock, short circuit or fire.



PROHIBITED

Do not stand or tread on the product. Do not force overloading on the product, or it will result in injury, malfunction and accident.

Do not use the chair near fire resource or flammable gas, or it will result in product distortion, malfunction and fir accident.

Do not use the product where aerosol spray products are being used or where oxygen is being administered. It will result in product distortion, malfunction and fire accident.

Do not clean or spray the product with abrasive cleaning detergent, alcohol or insecticide, or it will result in product distortion, electric shock and fire accident.

Please keep children and persons with reduced mental capabilities away from the running product, or it will result in injury.

- Please do not spray water or other liquid on the chair.

- Do not sit on the controller, do not drop or step on the controller. Do not pull over the wire .
- Do not press the button with sharp object or it will result in damage.

BEFORE USE

- This chair is packaged with the backrest folded. Before use, please raise up the backrest.
- When the temperature is too low to run the machine, please increase the ambient temperature gradually, do not increase the temperature in sudden. Please move the chair to the warm place and keep on waiting for 1 hour before starting.
 - → Or it will result in moisture of parts and abnormal operation.


Where to place the chair

Please make sure there is 50cm in front of and behind the chair to prevent the chair from scratching on the wall or other objects when reclining.




- Do not use the chair in the bathroom, sauna room or other places with high humidity?
- Please place the chair on the flat floor
- ■Do not use the chair in places with sundries and dust or with high ambient temperature (above 40'C)
- Do not put the chair in places with direct sunlight or near heating equipment with high temperature.
- Keep the chair away from the cigarette or flame.
- Lay a mat under the chair to prevent damages to the floor and for reduction of operation noise.
 (Do not lay electric blanket)
- Due to the fact that the chair is heavy, make sure that the floor will not be damaged when placing it on the floor.

■ Place put the chair 1 meter away from the TV, radio and other audio or video devices, otherwise the interruption noise may occur.





How to adjust the backrest



During the adjusting of the bachrest, the footrest will have coordinated up-down adjusting.



■ When the main power switch in the right front of the chair is on, the angel is adjustable. However angle adjustment is unavailable in case of "emergency stop.

Long time pressing function

- Just long press the button for 2 seconds, the backrest will be adjusted up-down automatically.
- (The angle is varies in different environment by different users)
- If you want to end the up/down automatically adjusting, please repress the button.



Ensure there is no person (especially children) or pets around when you adjust the chair. Moreover, ensure at least 50cm in front of and behind the chair, and there is no obstruction behind the backrest nor under the footrest.




Confirm the fabric

Before use, please confirm whether the fabric is damaged or not.

1 Loose the zipper



2) put your finger into the gap beween tha chair back and the chair cushion to check if there is damage on the cover





• Before using the chair, confirm that whether there is damage in the leather and fabric or on other parts. In case of damage, even the smallest tearing n the chair, please stop using immediately, turn off the power, unplug the chair and contact the customerservice center. Do not remove the cushion or broken fabric, or it will result in safety hazard.

ADJUST THE CHAIR

Sitting in the Chair

Under general circumstances, the rollers are laid folded at the lower waist of the backrest. Please ensure the position of the rollers for safety. If the rollers are laid otherwise, restart the chair, keep on waiting for the parts return to its initial condition and sit in the chair.




- Do not stand in the footrest when raising the footrest.
 - →The overload on the footrest will result in accident or reclining chair will cause personal injury.
- CAUTION Raise the chair back up before using. Enjoy the massage from light massage course. Adjust the angel of your reclining angel according to your body figure.

Adjust the head pad

Loose the magic buckle on the back of the head pad. Readjust the position of the pad.





- Please lay the pad in a correct position. Or it will result in wrong kneading points and abnormal
- Do not shake or throw the pad, for there is the steel balancer inthe pad. Keep the children away. Or it will result in damage.

How to move

Please switch off the power before moving the chair and pull the power cord out of the outlet.


Move with casters

Please raise the chair back upside, hold the Let the b ckrest flatwise, hold the handle on both sides of the footrest and raise the footrest, move the chair with casters.



In order to prevent damages to the floor, please lay a mat on the floor before moving. Uplift to move

the top of the back cover and the both sides of the footrest, lift up the chair to move.



In case of the falling of the chair, this may damage to the floor or cause personnel injury. Please hold fast to the armrest and the legrest.

CAUTION

- The chair cannot be moved if the passage is less than 74 cm in width
- Contact the dealer in case you cannot move the chair normally.
- Due to the heavy weight of the chair, make sure that it will not damage your waist or other parts of your body during moving.
- Thte controller is connected on the chair. Make sure to avoid its dropping off during moving
- Do not move the chair with person loaded.
- Please move the chair after unplugging.
 - → Otherwise it may cause damages to the power plug, cause fire disaster or electric shock.

How to switch on the power

1 Plug the power cord to the switch socket on the back of the chair, and the other en power outlet.

2 Turn on the main power switch in the right front of the chair.



If the rollers gets stuck, turn on the switch and press the ON/OFF button, the roller will be back to its initial postion.

∆WARNING

⚠ CAUTION

- Do not use external transformer or it will result in accident or fire.
- Be sure the main switch is "OFF" before plug in the chair.
- Be sure the chair is well plugged in.
- Before use, please read the manual carefully and set the chair in light of the requirement to ensure the normal operation.
